

VIGIL HONOR NOMINATION

The Vigil honor is the highest honor that the lodge can bestow upon its members. It is a high mark of distinction and recognition reserved for those Scouts and Scouter members of the Order, who by reason of exceptional service, personal effort, and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions beyond the immediate responsibilities of their position. Under no circumstance should tenure in Scouting or the Order of the Arrow be considered a reason enough for a Vigil honor recommendation.

Vigil honor members must at all times conduct themselves in accordance with the highest ideals of Scouting, the Order of the Arrow, and the Vigil honor. Membership cannot be won by a person's conscious endeavor. It comes as a recognition of his or her unselfish leadership in service. This fact should be given careful consideration in recommendation of candidates for the Vigil honor.

Any Arrowman who has been an active Brotherhood member for at least two (2) years upon the meeting of the Vigil Selection Committee, is registered in Scouting, and in good standing with Chicksa Lodge 202 is eligible for recommendation for the Vigil honor.
